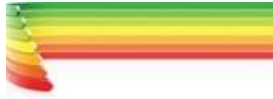

New Energy Labelling Regulation (EU) 2017/1369

A new regulation setting a framework for energy labelling was signed by the European Parliament and the Council on 4 July 2017 and published in the Official Journal on 28 July 2017 (Regulation (EU) 2017/1369).

This regulation, repealing Directive 2010/30/EU, sets a framework that will allow to, within others, as described in the European Commission [website](#), and quoted as follows:

- “A return to the clearer A to G class label, by removing the cumbersome A+ to A+++ classes from existing energy labels within a well-defined timeframe;
- The introduction of a product registration database to support market surveillance activities by the Member States;
- A public database containing all energy efficiency labels, giving consumers a better tool to compare the energy efficiency of household appliances”.
