New list of Harmonised standards under RED

After previous publication, on June 8th, of harmonised standards list under Radio Equipment Directive 2014/53/EU in the Official Journal of the European Union, a new publication has been issued again on 14th July (text reference 2017/C 229/02).

“Commission communication in the framework of the implementation of Directive 1999/5/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on radio equipment and telecommunications terminal equipment and the mutual recognition of their conformity and Directive 2014/53/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on the harmonisation of the laws of the Member States relating to the making available on the market of radio equipment and repealing Directive 1999/5/EC.

Harmonised Standards included in this new list that were not included in the previous publication are:

- EN 300 440 V2.1.1- Short Range Devices (SRD); Radio equipment to be used in the 1 GHz to 40 GHz frequency range; Harmonised Standard covering the essential requirements of article 3.2 of Directive 2014/53/EU.
- EN 301 357 V2.1.1- Cordless audio devices in the range 25 MHz to 2,000 MHz; Harmonised Standard covering the essential requirements of article 3.2 of Directive 2014/53/EU.

Radio Equipment: Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/1354

On July 21st, the Official Journal of the European Union published Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/1354 of 20 July 2017 specifying how to present the information provided for in Article 10(10) of Directive 2014/53/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council.

This Regulation specifies how to present the information (pictogram) provided for in Article 10 (10) of Directive 2014/53 / EU on the CE marking of radio equipment and applies only to radio equipment subject to restrictions for putting into service or to requirements for authorisation of use in at least one Member State.

Ecodesign requirements for air heating products, cooling products, high temperature process chillers and fan coil units – Methods of measurement and calculation

On July 14th, the Official Journal of the European Union published Commission communication in the framework of the implementation of Commission Regulation (EU) 2016/2281 implementing Directive 2009/125/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for air heating products, cooling products, high temperature process chillers and fan coil units.

In this text, references of transitional methods of measurement and calculation for the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2016/2281, and in particular Annexes III and IV thereto, have been published.

EN 60335-2-9: Harmonised standard with a restriction

The 21st July Official Journal of the European Union included the reference to Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2017/1357 of 19 July 2017 on the publication with a restriction in the Official Journal of the European Union of the reference of standard EN 60335-2-9:2003, as last amended by A13:2010, on particular requirements for grills, toasters and similar portable cooking appliances under Regulation (EU) No 1025/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

This standard has been harmonised under Directive 2014/35/EU, but with the following restriction:

- The application of the following parts of standard EN 60335-2-9:2003, as last amended by A13:2010, does not confer a presumption of conformity to the safety objectives laid down in point 1(c) of Annex I to Directive 2014/35/EU, in conjunction with point 2(b) of that Annex:
 - Footnote b of Table Z101 in Section 11
 - The parts of Section 7.1 which refer to footnote b of Table Z101
 - The parts of Section 11.Z10x which refer to ventilation openings
